Official Rules:

Entry requirements: Enter as many times as you'd like. YOUR DESIGN MUST BE ORIGINAL and can be hand-drawn or created on a computer.* **The simpler, the better!** A very complex pattern may not transfer well to a T-shirt. No photography may be used in your design. Fill out the entry form below and attach submission(s). Any message, slogan or picture on clothing must be consistent with the school's standards and testimony; which is to honor Christ.

1. **Size:** The original must be 8x10 inches.
2. **Color:** T-shirt color is **WHITE** for PS/Elem – **PURPLE** for MS/HS. **Ink colors:** Choose up to three colors from this selection: **tan, black, gold, purple and white.**
3. **Computer requirements:** If your artwork is done on computer, print out an 8X10 color copy for the contest entry. If your design is chosen, we will ask you for your digital original. (**Resolution:** 300 DPI minimum - **Required file type:** gif, jpg, or png)
4. **Deadline:** Artwork and form must be turned in to an office by **noon on Friday, February 3rd.**
5. **Winners:** Artwork will be narrowed down to the top 5 that best reflects BCS Jog, the Jog-a-thon theme and verse. Students will then have the opportunity to vote for their favorite design out of the top 5. There will be one winner for PS/Elem and one for MS/HS. Winners will have their names printed on the shirt. Winning designs will be revealed the week of February 13th.
