



Bradshaw Christian High School 2019-2020 Christian Service Expectations

While community service is a requirement and looked upon favorably by colleges, it is our hope that by meeting these expectations, you will experience the transformative power of God's love working in and through you! Jesus said that what we've done to the least of these, we've done unto him (Matthew 25). If we clothe, feed, serve or demonstrate charity to "the least of these," we are participating in something greater than mere good works, which is why Christian Service is a vital part of BCS Campus Ministry, worth 20% of your Bible Grade and serves as the Bible midterm and final.

Requirements:

The intent of Christian Service expectations are to inspire you to look beyond immediate campus needs and other convenient methods of serving and find an organization in which you can lend practical support. If you have questions as to what qualifies, please ask your Bible teacher.

Using the instructions on the back of this page, you must sign up for a mobileserve account by **September 6**.

The following guidelines must be met, 8 hours by **Dec. 9 (for Sem. 1)** and the remaining 8 hours by **May 18** (for Sem. 2):

1. Serve a total of 16 hours:
 - for which you are not receiving financial gain;
 - for which family members are neither recipients or supervisors.
2. Using MOBILESERVE, you must meet the following criteria in order to receive credit for your hours. If any of these three criteria are not met, you will NOT receive credit for the hours. *If you do not have access to a mobile device, you must speak to Mr. Denton before September 6.
 - **Have site administrator verify your service hours via email.**
 - **Take a selfie at service site**
 - **Check in using geo-location**
 - **Write at least 50 words of reflection on your service with each service time.**
3. If you served during Summer 2019, you will need to upload as much info that you have before September 6 to receive credit.
4. The BCS due date policy of 10% off for one day late, 20% off for two, and no credit for three applies to service hours as well.
5. If you have met all requirements by the deadline, you will be exempt from taking a Bible midterm/final exam.

Some examples of possible Christian Service activities:

- tutoring through Boys and Girls Club or after school at an elementary or middle school
- helping at a hospital or elder care home.
- volunteering with a community team such as Little League or youth soccer
- helping the community through church-related activities
- removing graffiti, cleaning a park or creek or working with local parks and recreation
- giving blood (1 hour of credit each time blood is given)
