



# 2023 Summer School at Bradshaw Christian

We are offering select courses in our high school summer program this year, allowing opportunities for students to advance in their course work and enrich their education. These courses provide credit towards graduation requirements at BCHS. If a student is planning to attend a school other than BCHS in the following school year, check first with your school to see if these courses will transfer.

Classes are limited and enrollment will be on a first come first served basis. Students must be entering high school the next school year in order to enroll. Students will not be officially enrolled until tuition and fees are paid. BCHS reserves the right to cancel classes that do not have sufficient enrollment.

School will be open 15 minutes before and after class for drop off and pick up.

Class Times: 10:00am – 2:30pm Monday through Friday.  
No School Monday June 19<sup>th</sup> and Monday - Wednesday July 3<sup>rd</sup> – July 5<sup>th</sup>

Materials: Textbooks will be provided, but students must bring their own binder, paper, writing utensils, composition notebook. Students should bring their devices as well.

Attendance: This is a fast-paced course and regular attendance is crucial. If a student expects to miss more than 2 days during the session, summer school may not be the best fit.

Lunch: For classes that extend through the lunch hour, students will need to bring a sack lunch. There will be no hot lunch, and students may not leave for lunch and return.

Expectations: All BCHS rules of conduct and behavior will be enforced. Dress code will be “free dress” attire according to our student handbook, not uniform dress.

Passing Credit: For courses that count as credit towards graduation, each course must be passed with a C- or better.

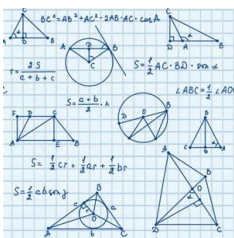
Class Size: If a class does not meet the minimum required number of students, it will not be offered and payments will be refunded.

## 6 Week Sessions

The following summer school options are entire courses condensed into 6 weeks of classroom instruction and homework. Because these courses are accelerated, students are required to be in good academic standing in order to participate. (Above a 2.0 GPA, no D's or F's.) These classes require a great amount of initiative and a strong work ethic, and regular student attendance and participation is essential. In order for these classes to count towards graduation credit requirements, a 'C-' or better must be received for the class.



### Mathematics: Geometry

Cost: \$650 (\$675 if registered after May 5)  
10 credits toward math graduation requirements.

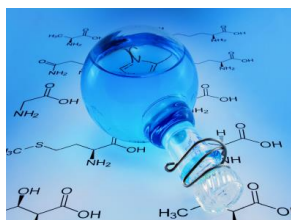
With more advanced math courses in our annual course offerings, taking Geometry allows students to advance in the math track, opening up opportunities for Statistics, and AP Calculus.

Geometry is a required high school math course, taken immediately after Algebra 1 (which is a prerequisite). Students will focus on logic and problem solving using foundational algebraic principles as well as spatial reasoning. This traditional course in plane and spatial geometry includes proof and reasoning skills, parallel and perpendicular lines, properties of triangles, polygons, quadrilaterals, circles, area, volume, right triangles and trigonometry, similarity, transformations, and probability. A graphing calculator is required.

Because Geometry is taken between Algebra 1 and Algebra 2, taking this course over the summer allows for an easier transition into Algebra 2. Foundational concepts from Algebra 1 are still fresh in mind from the previous year. Taking Geometry as a summer school course also allows students to accelerate their current math track, opening up more opportunities for advanced math classes such as AP Calculus and Statistics.

**Extra materials needed:** graph paper, a calculator, and a composition book.

**Important Note:** BCS Students are expected to take a Math class every year they attend Bradshaw Christian. Summer Geometry will help them get into high level math classes but will NOT excuse them from taking math classes in future years. Students who take Summer Geometry will end up with 5 years of Math credit on their transcript. ### Science: Chemistry

Cost: \$650 (\$675 if registered after May 5)  
10 credits toward lab science graduation requirements.

Chemistry is the study of the fundamental material that makes up all matter. Students will be introduced to concepts of modern chemistry including: the atom, molecular structure, chemical bonds, conservation of matter and energy, stoichiometry, gases, acids and bases, reaction rates and solutions. This course counts as a lab science and will include investigative labs that reinforce each concept. This course is intensive and requires a good amount of math.

**Prerequisites:** Students need to have taken both Biology and Algebra 2 before they take this class.

## **3 Week Session**

### **English: One Semester Re-take (Any Grade Level)**

**Dates: July 10 – July 28**

Cost: \$325 (\$350 if registered after May 5)  
5 credits to make up for a semester grade of D or F.



The High School English summer course is designed for students who need to re-take one semester of High School English and typically have struggled with high school writing. During this course, students will be taught study skills, how to organize their work- using Word or Google docs, and the steps needed to create, edit, and complete academic writings. In addition to this, students will read and annotate a novella- learning how to make connections between literature and the real world, ending the unit with the writing of an argumentative essay. Due to the short time-frame for this course, students should not be absent nor tardy. Daily, students must bring a charged device that has access to the internet, as well as a highlighter, pen, and lined paper.
